The Chattooga Chamber would like to invite you to nominate a candidate from your school to participate in **Leadership Chattooga** *Student Edition* **2026**. The purpose of this program is to provide high school juniors and seniors with a greater awareness of community issues, needs, services and resources. Equipping our future partners in business, government and community with the tools they need to be effective and successful leaders in their chosen fields is the goal of the Chattooga Chamber of Commerce, and we appreciate your continued support to reach that goal each year.

The application process is simple, asking for basic information from both the candidate and the school (parents if homeschooled). The form is on the next page, or you may apply online through our Facebook page or on our website: ChattoogaChamber.org. Click the "What We Do" tab and select "Leadership Development" from the dropdown menu.

Orientation begins September 10, 2025 and sessions will be conducted (usually) the second Wednesday of each month (Sep '25-Mar '26. We do not meet in December). The course will begin with an orientation session conducted by Heather Casey of Lead-Strong 4:14 and Diane Vinyard with Living Life on Target.

The orientation session is required.

There will be five additional full-day sessions planned covering the following:

- Relationship-Building is Key
- Effective Communication
- Understanding Values
- Community Diversity
- Collaboration
- State Capitol Visit
- Work Ethics
- Putting Into Practice: Team Building & Scavenger Hunt

This opportunity is limited to twelve participants from Chattooga County. Minimum age is 18; no one is too old for the program. The sessions will usually begin at the Civic Center¹. From there, we may then visit other points of interest around the county and region. The Chamber will provide transportation for field trips, if available. Participants must be able to board and travel in the county van or make arrangements to be transported in a personal vehicle.

A one-day visit to Atlanta will be planned according to our state representative's schedule and pertinent activities going on in the State Capitol and elsewhere in Atlanta.

Deadline to apply is August 29, 2025!

There is no tuition for the Student Edition.

^{*}Participants must attend Orientation at least 4 out of the 5 additional sessions in order to graduate in April 2024. Medical and family emergencies are excused.
